Summary of study/report	<p>The national plan to combat violent radicalization and terrorist networks, in April 2014, made the prevention of radicalization one of the main axes of the plan.</p> <p>Almost two years after the implementation of the system, the government's response was truly initiated at the deconcentrated level with the development of constructive partnership and the mobilization of various and varied actors.</p> <p>However, in order to improve the effectiveness of the system for preventing radicalization, the provision and dissemination to the prefectures and deconcentrated services of the State of tools, procedural files and good practice forms seem indispensable.</p> <p>For this reason, this guide on the prevention of radicalization, drawn up within the framework of an interministerial working group, aims to help local actors to structure a range of support for families and care for the persons reported "As radicalized".</p> <p>This practical tool should facilitate the reporting of the situation of radicalization on the toll-free number, improve the coordination and territorial animation of the system and finally strengthen the implementation of the prevention of radicalization through, on the one hand, accompanying measures and psychological and social care, but also through complementary collective actions.</p>
