- 2. Is it state accredited or not?
- 3. Has quality assurance been provided? Impact assessment and follow up
- 4. Number of participants
- 5. Regularity of courses
- 6. Time-span of activities/courses
- 7. Is it competence-based or knowledge-focused?
- 8. Methodology:
 - activity
 - uses the means of experiential education
 - uses visual material (photos, videos, etc.)
 - view altering
 - frontal or group activities
 - knowledge-focus or competence-based

Assessment

- number of participants and their participation,
- has there been any outcome (video, publication in print, etc),
- evaluation of satisfaction (immediately after the program) of the participants and of the teachers,
- for assessing the competences is there a questionnaire (diagnostic tool) before and after the program?
