

Malta


- Located in the middle of the Mediterranean Sea

- **Size:** 27 km long by 14.5 km width
- **Population:** 408,333 (July 2011 est)
- **Surface Area:** 320 sq km (124 sq miles)



The Department of Criminology

- Acts as advisor to the government on criminal justice matters
- Teaches probation officers, police officers and other criminal justice personnel
- Acts as a resource centre in matters pertaining to criminal justice

this year






Corradino Correctional Facility (CCF)
