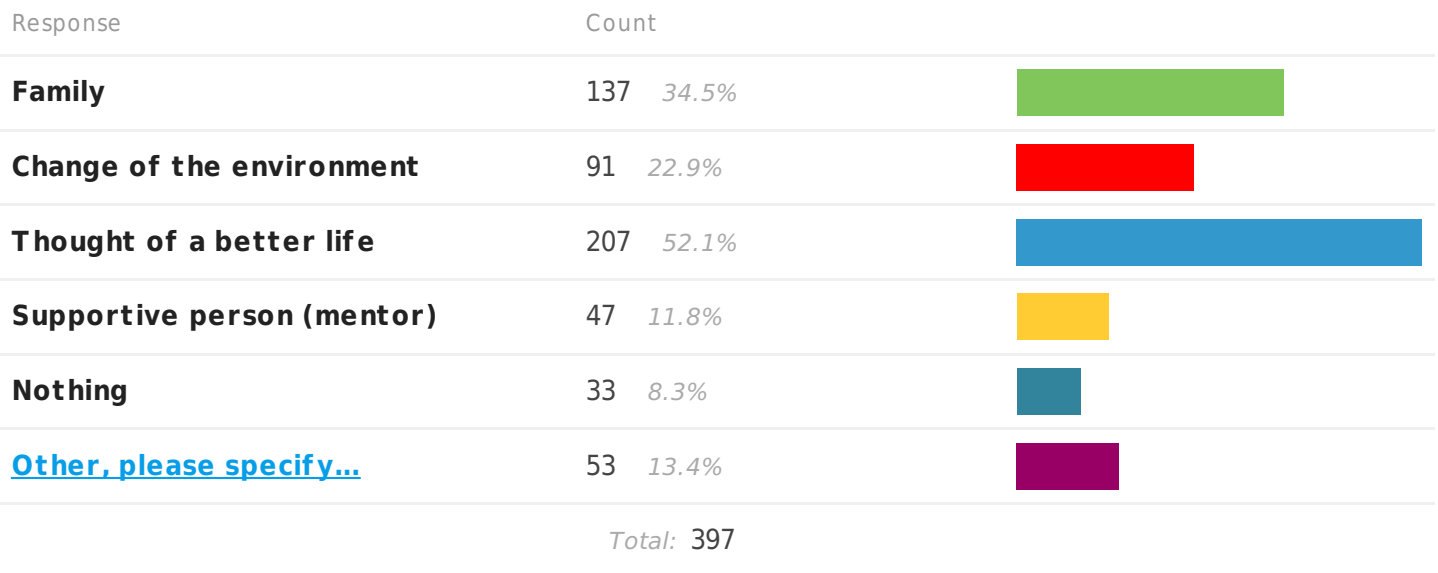

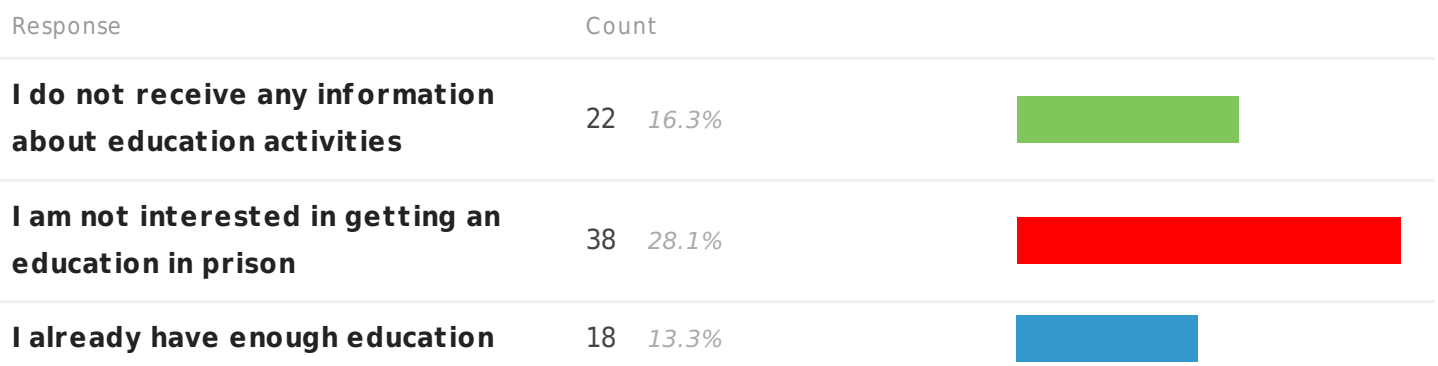

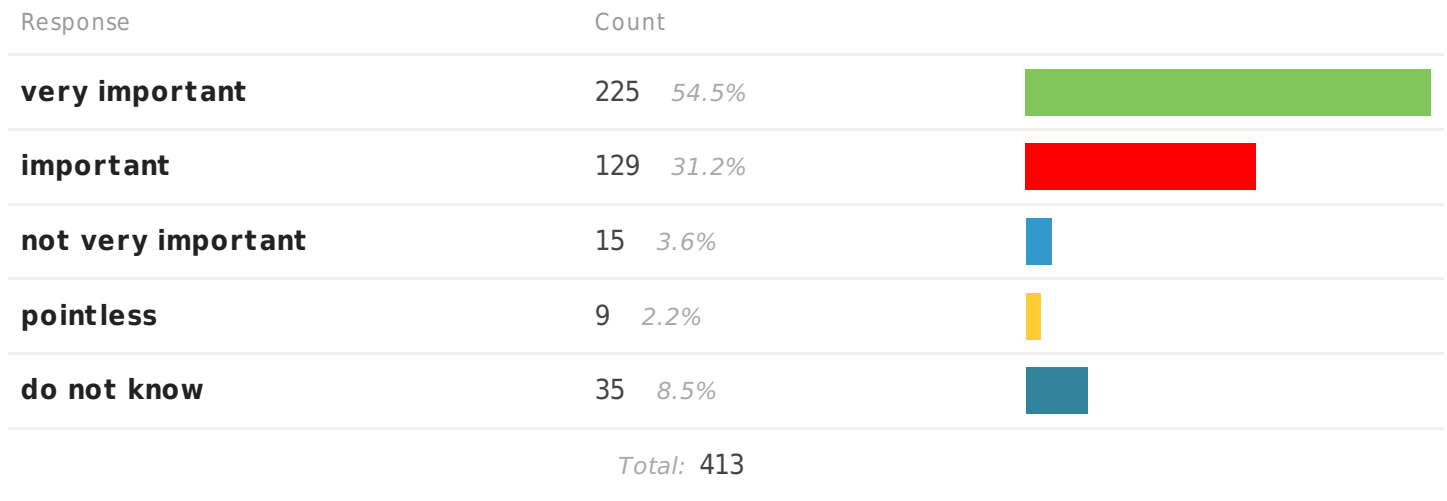

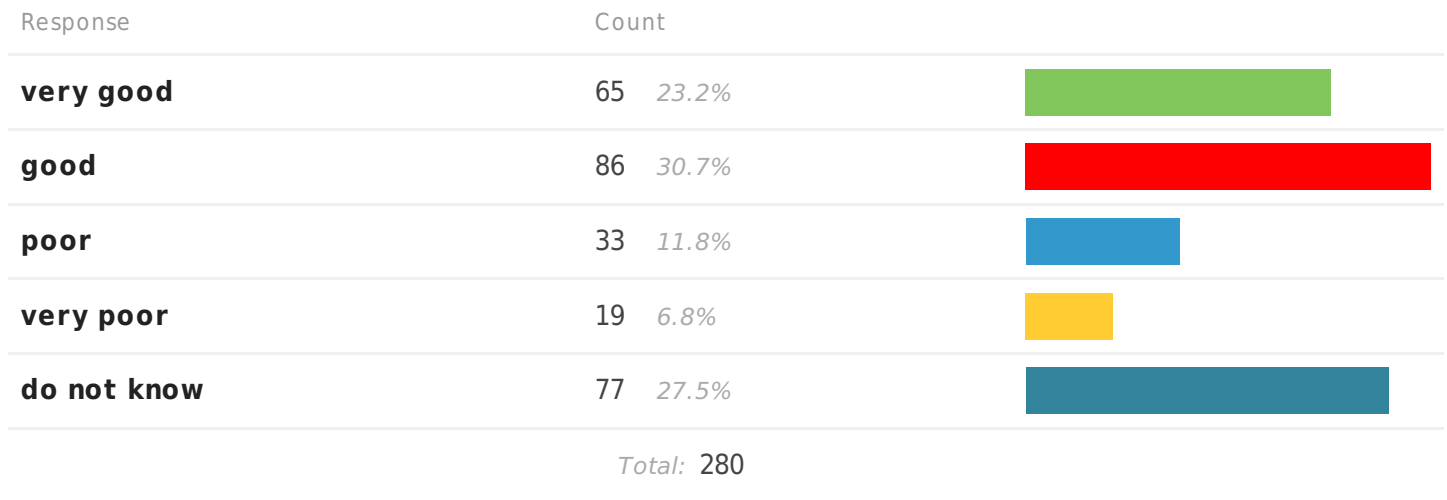
35a) How do I value education in general?

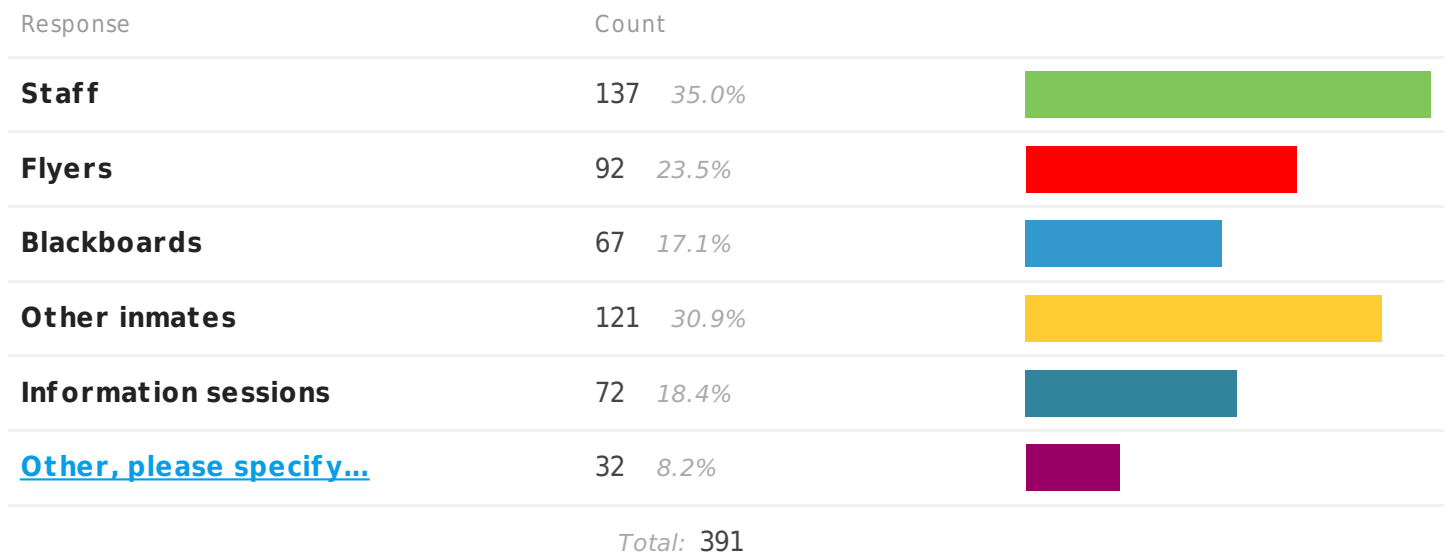
35b) What does prison education mean to me?



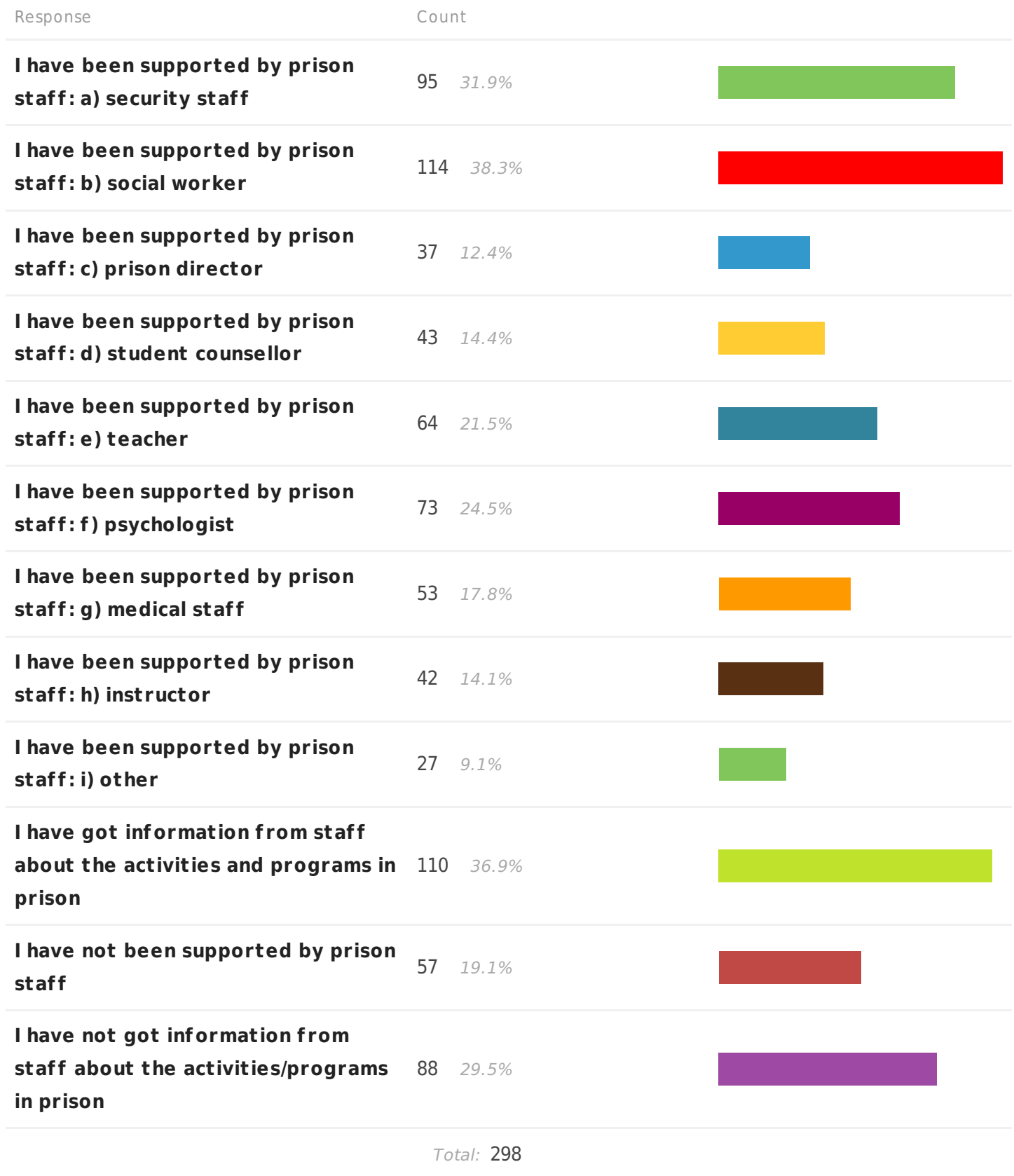
36. Level of educational Counselor's support



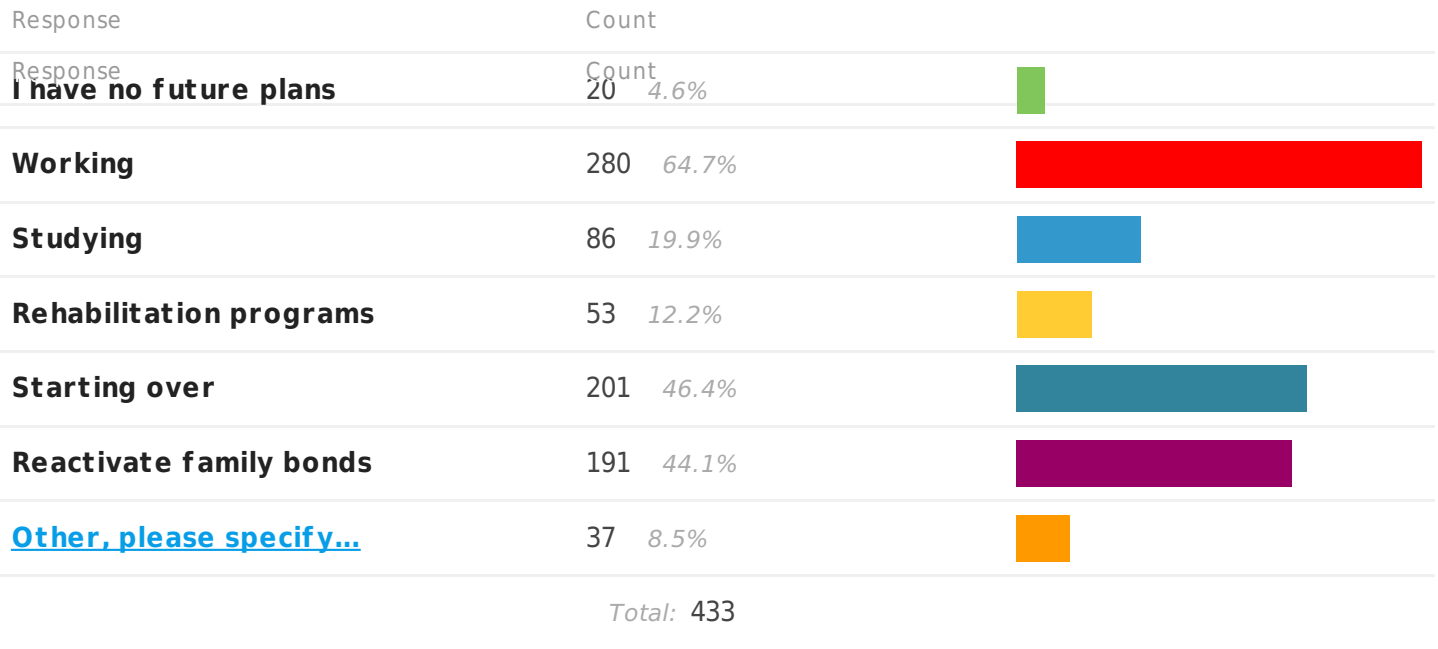
37. How did I hear about the last activity I participated in?



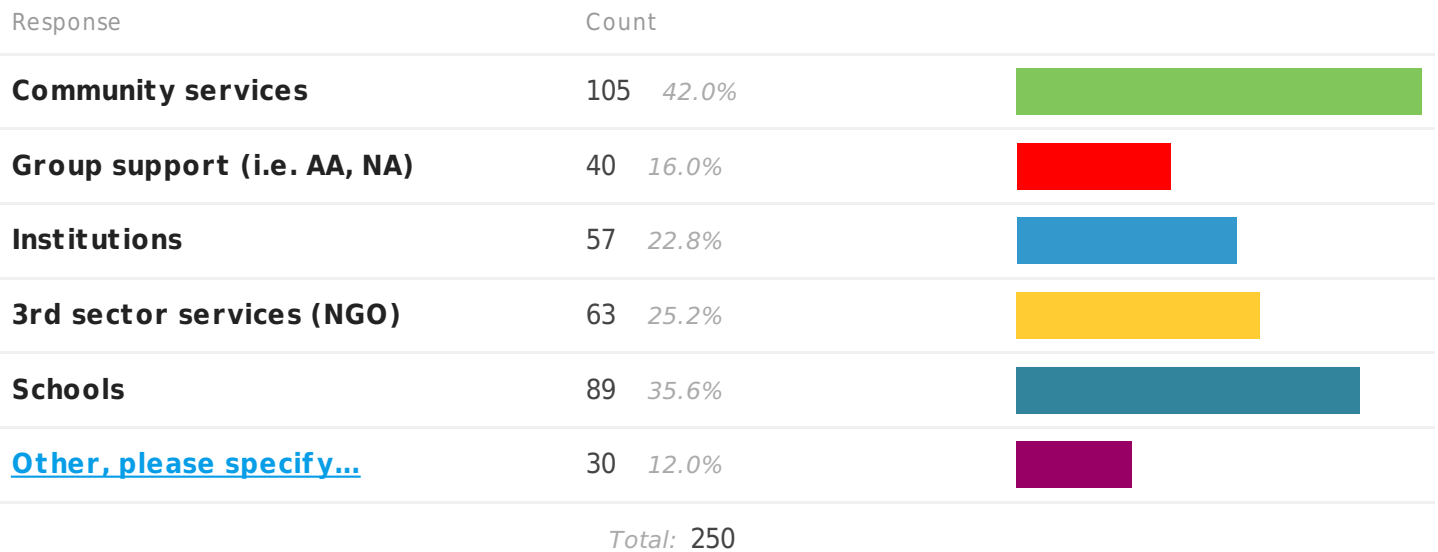

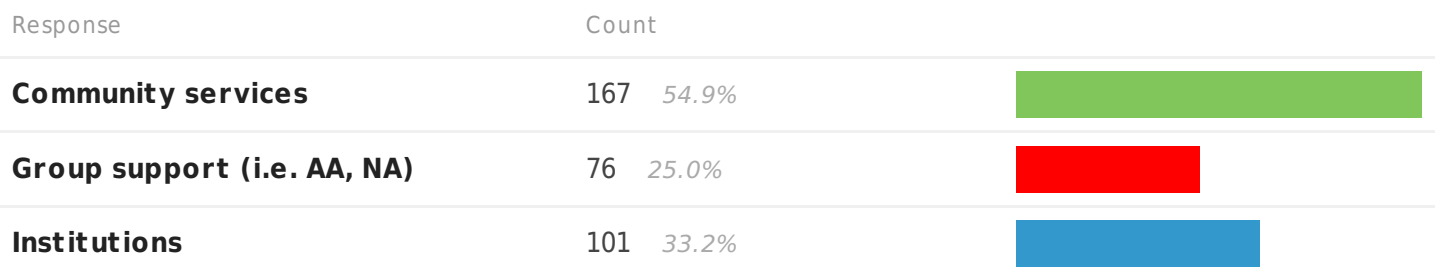
