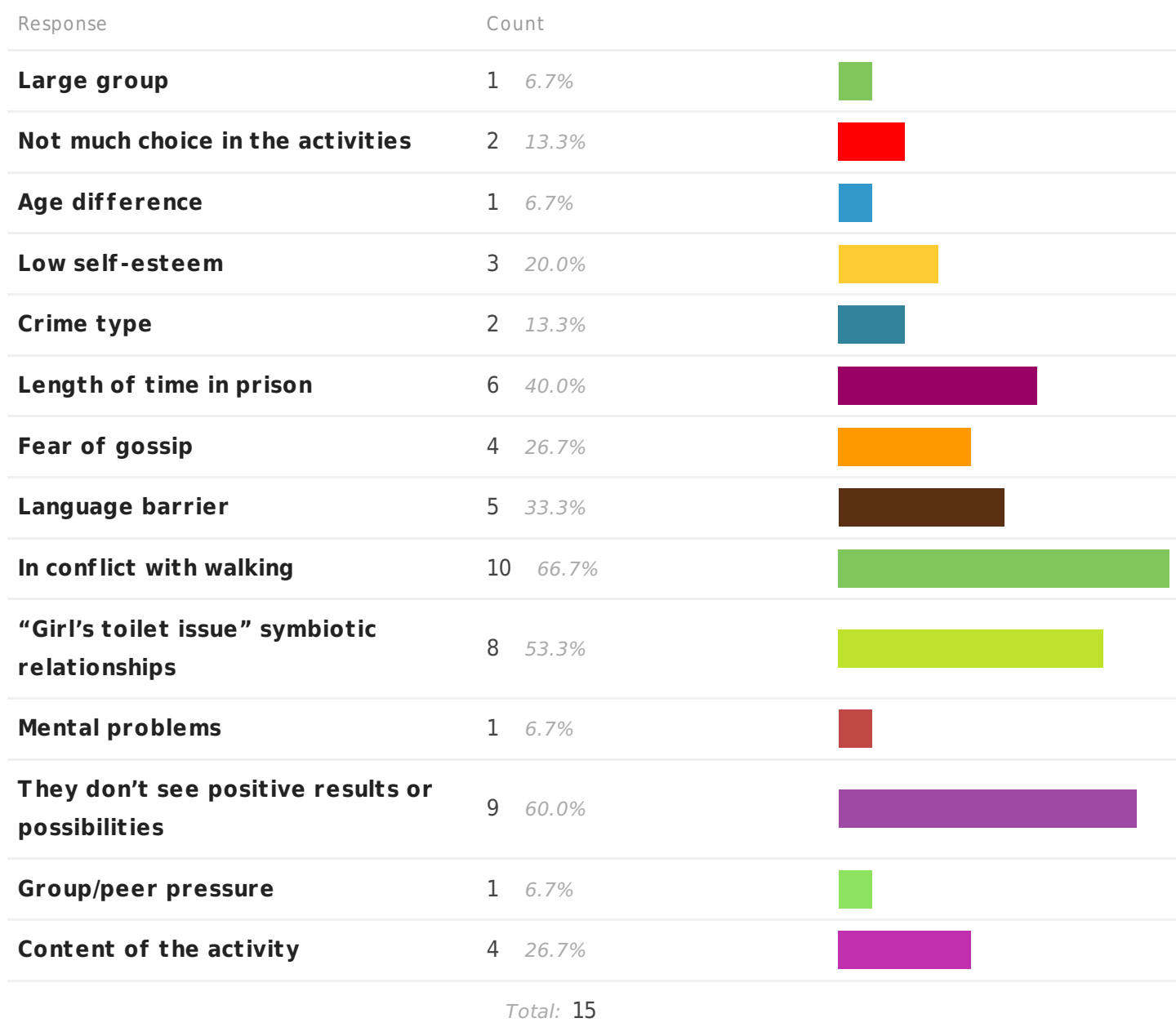

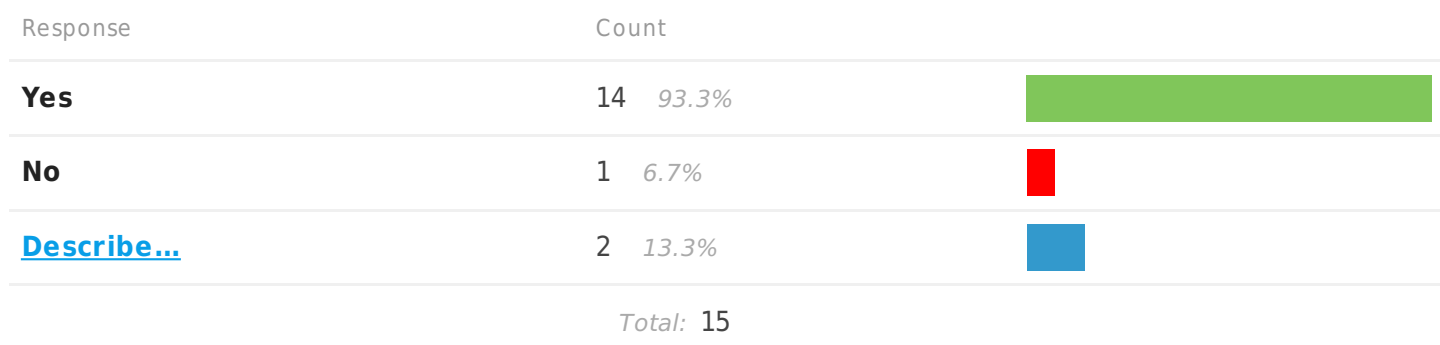

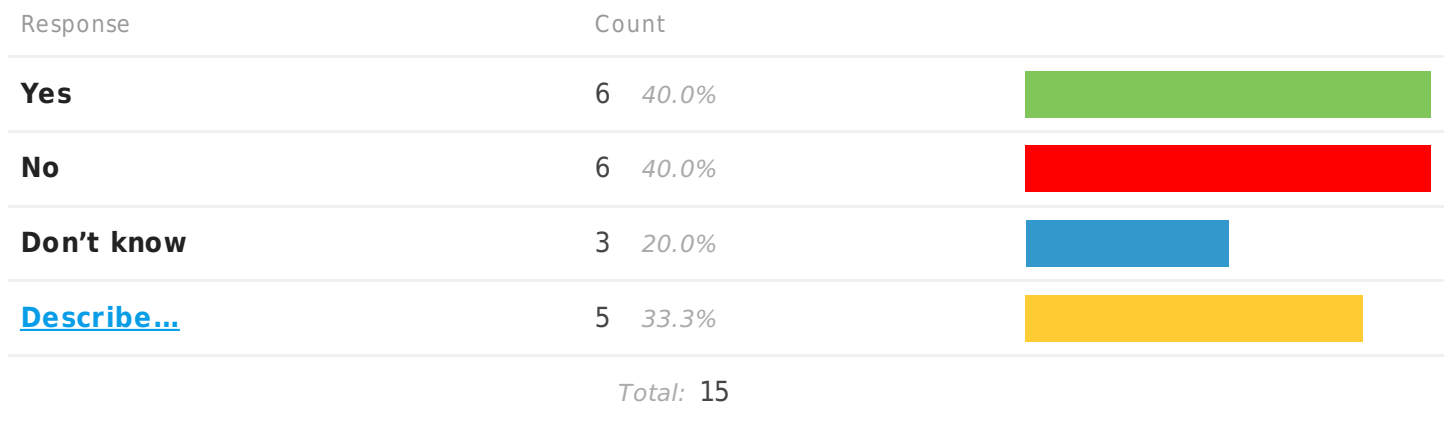
4b) What reasons do you think demotivate female inmates to participate in activities



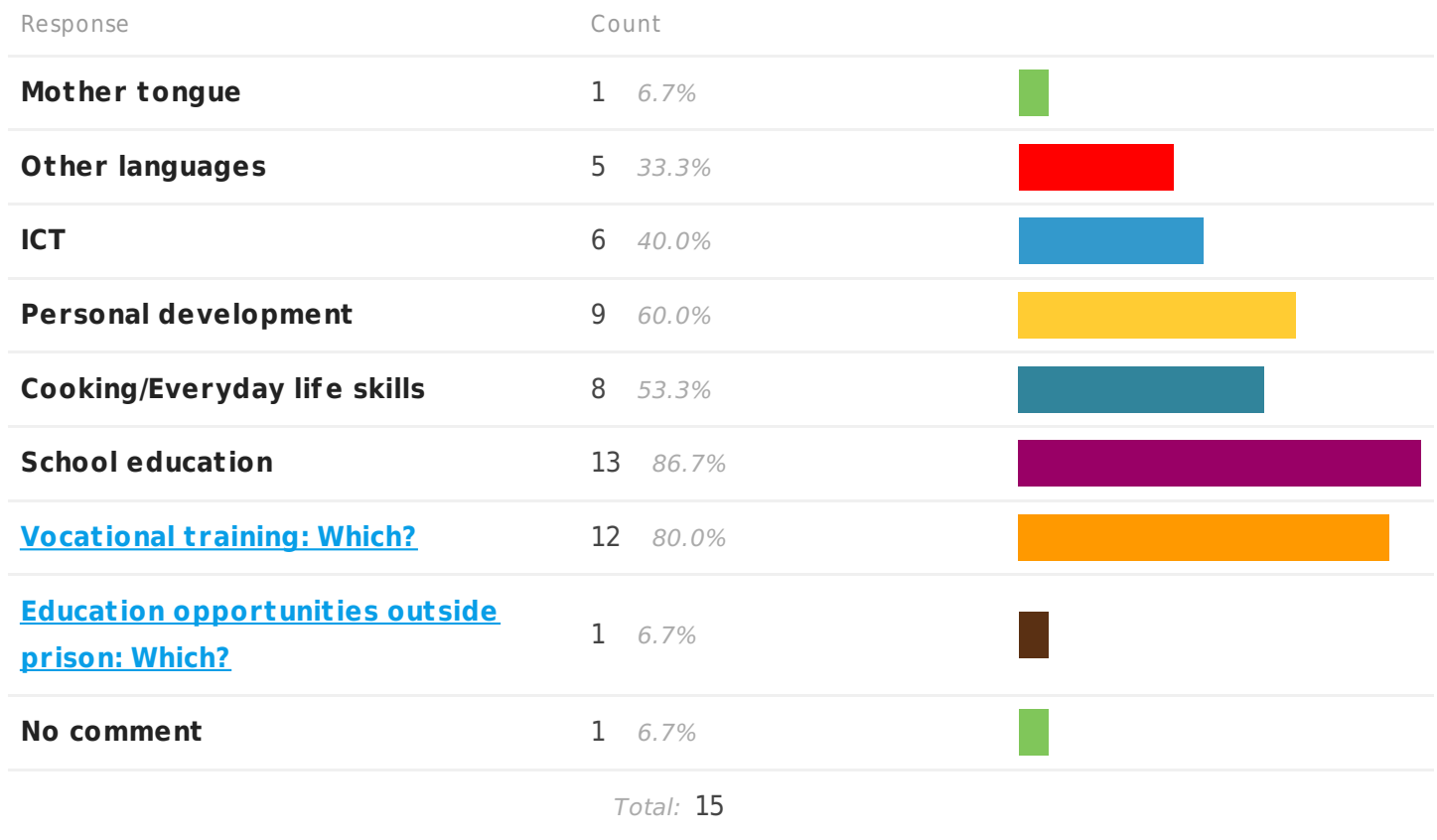
5. Do you think that education in prison is a strategic priority in your organisation?



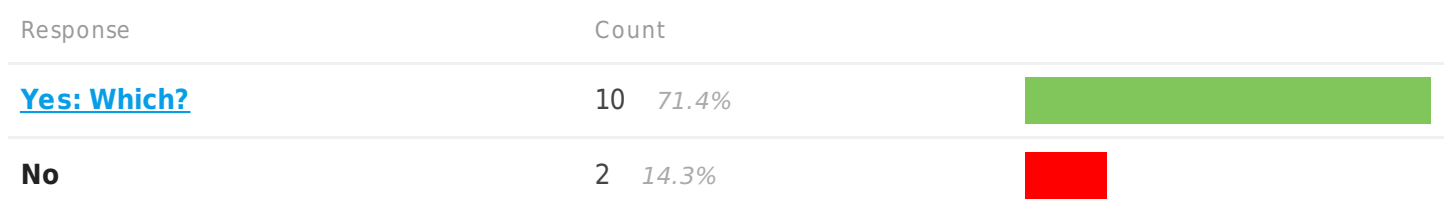
6. In your opinion, does the current offer meet the real needs of female inmates?

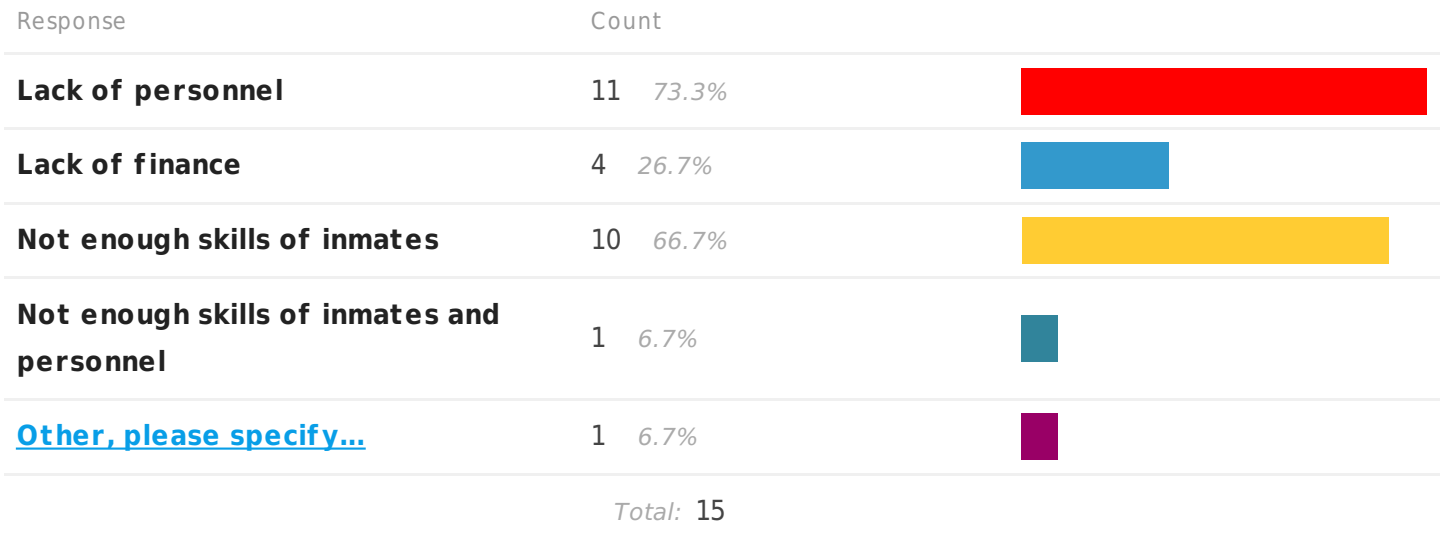

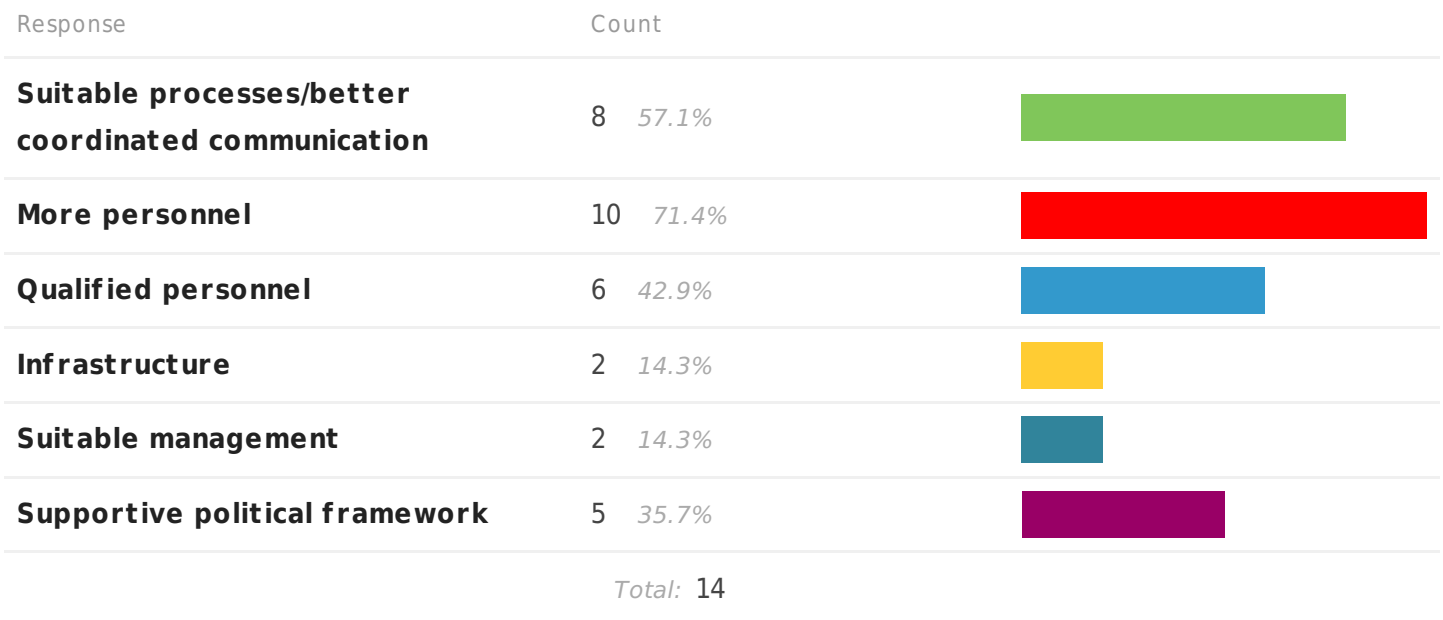
