

The Catalonian prison system

Catalonia has autonomy to run its own prison system since 1984



Facilities

- 15 prisons: 10 ordinary + 5 open prisons
- 5 new prisons since 2007
- One psychiatric unit / One Hospital Pavilion

Population

- 8,700 inmates
- 7% of women
- 14% remand
- 1,000 on parole
- 1,500 in open regime
- 149 (1.7%) in high security units
- Prison population rate: 113 (Spain :131)

The Catalonian prison system

Catalonia has autonomy to run its own prison system since 1984




Staff

- Total staff: 4,644
- Custody staff: 3,300 (71%)
- Rehabilitation staff: 840 (18%)
- Education staff: 140 (not employed by the Prison Administration)

Five lines of action



Environmental design: Unit management approach



- Small units: 100 inmates
- To improve social interaction, decisions and cooperation
- Organizing daily life
- Stable and multi-disciplinary teams
- Central facilities
- Specialized areas



In 2015:


1,081 in scheduled outings
