



Practical information for C2 in Barcelona

Participants at the C2 in Barcelona will be hosted at Fundesplai <http://www.alberguesplai-barcelona.com/ca/>, which is a hostel located in the town of El Prat, the municipality where the Airport is located which is halfway to the city of Barcelona.

The price per night/single room, breakfast and taxes included is 52€.

From the Airport to Fundesplai

We recommend taking the metro L9 departing from T 1 and T2 and get off at the metro stop called *Parc Nou*. Check the route here <https://goo.gl/maps/KgCjmbGGE9u>

You can buy a single ticket from the vending machines at the metro station with cash or credit card. Please, make sure you purchase the specific airport ticket for L9 which costs 4.50€ as it is more expensive than the regular tickets for the rest of the metro lines and urban bus lines.

Metro L9 runs from 5:00 am to midnight from Monday to Sunday.

From Terminal 2, you also have the option of taking the PR 1 bus (yellow) and get off at the first stop *Av. Onze de Setembre – Riu Anoia*

You can purchase a single ticket from the driver only with cash.

There are also the train (called Renfe) as well as aerobus and other bus lines, but these are a better option to reach other venues in Barcelona and are not at all convenient to reach Fundesplai at El Prat.

From Fundesplai to the centre of Barcelona

The fastest and easy option is to take the metro L9 from Parc Nou to Torrassa, where you shall change trains and take metro L1 and get off at Plaça Catalunya, from where you can reach many of the key cultural and tourist attractions of the city <https://goo.gl/maps/u4u84Vj6NcJ2>

On Friday you can get off at Urquinaona instead, as it is closer to the venue where the sports' instructors seminar will take place, the Centre for Legal and Specialised Training <https://goo.gl/maps/u4u84Vj6NcJ2>



Public transport network

El Prat is a town that belongs to the metropolitan area of Barcelona and it is well served by the same public transport network. Here you can check-up metro and bus lines in English including fares and timetables <https://www.tmb.cat/en/barcelona-transport>

To get from the Airport to Fundesplai by L9 you need to purchase the special airport single ticket of 4.50€ to be purchased from the vending machines.

However, once at Fundesplai if you want to take metro or bus to go Barcelona or somewhere within the metropolitan area, it is advisable to buy a 10 trip pass which is called **T-10 1 zone**. This is a travel card valid for 10 journeys within zone 1 (Barcelona and metropolitan area including El Prat). One journey allows changing metros and urban buses within a time-span of 75 minutes. Hence from the hotel at El Prat to any location within Barcelona, you will only spend one trip including the metro changes or urban buses you need to take. (If you change from metro to bus, you will need to validate the pass once at the bus but it will not be spending and additional trip if it is done within the 75' since the first validation)
