Conclusions of review	It is possible to deduce some guidelines on radicalization prevention: - There is no typical profile for recognizing people at risk of radicalization. -Prevention should be based on collaboration between partners in education, integration and social services. -Prevention tools must be based on existing structures. -Responses must be developed locally. - The processes of sharing information and the early detection of radicalization need to be clearly defined. Below are some recommendations and observations on the measures to be taken: integrated approach (interdisciplinary and inter-institutional cooperation and the exchange of information between the actors involved in the prevention and possibly also with the judicial and security authorities, involving as much as possible the representatives of the Muslim communities); Education (It is necessary to further improve media skills as well as the use of the Internet and social media among young people, parents and teachers), Religion (Consideration should be given to the possibility of establishing a national contact to which local authorities and Muslim associations can address to religious matters affecting the

whole country), Integration (It is necessary to promote the
provision of language courses as an integration tool), Raising
