For participants coming by plane Just in front of Bordeaux Mérignac Airport take BUS LIANE 1 (public transport, one ticket/per person is 1,50 euro) till LYCEES de MERIGNAC then catch TRAM line **A** **Direction** : DRAVEMONT and drop out at JEAN ZAY It’s just 2 stops before the end of line A. If you miss it you can also leave at the next one LA MAREGUE.

Then you have a little walk to do (by around 500 meters), you will cross the motorway and then you are near (stay on the left side of the road).

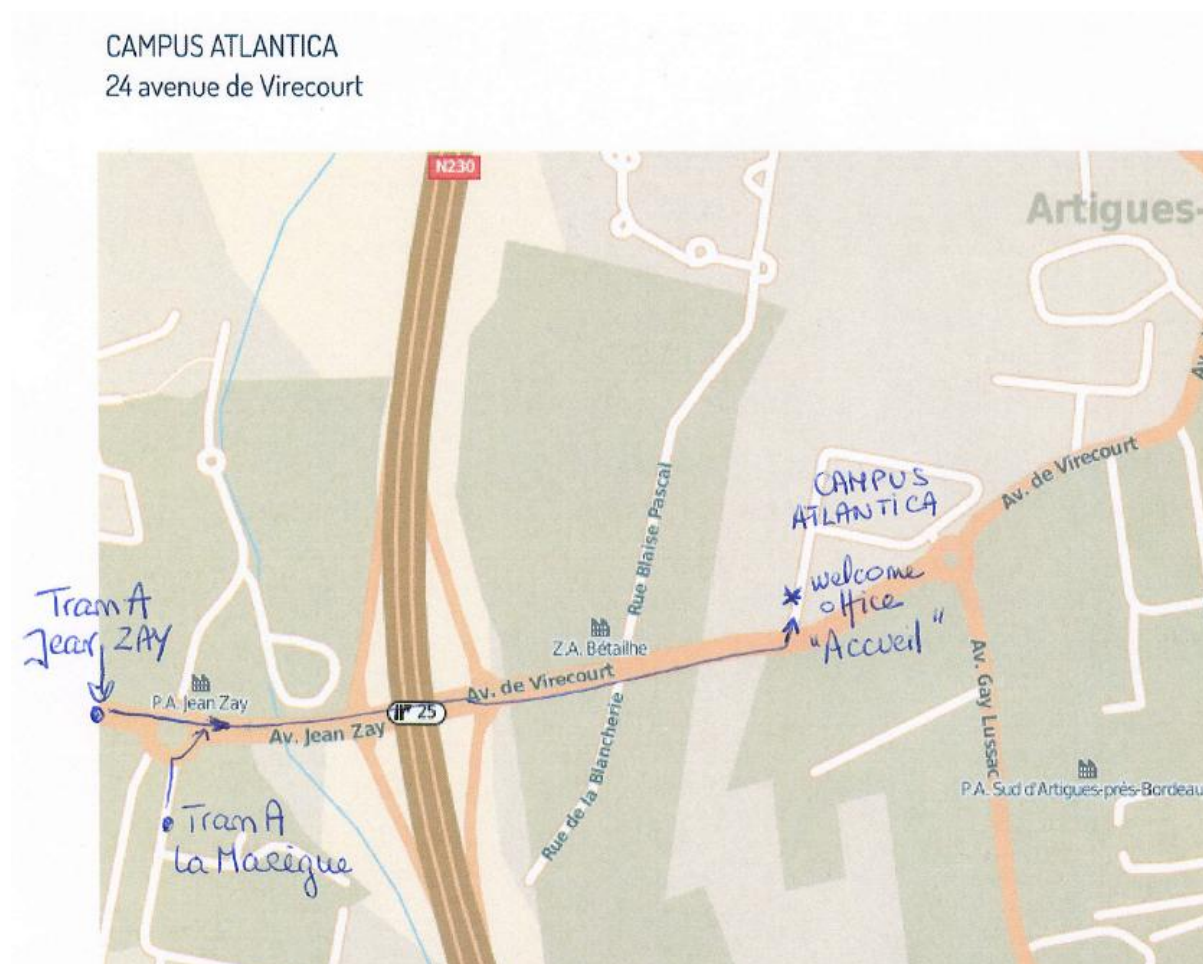
Ticket for BUS and TRAM is the same one during one hour and you can take as many transports as you want within one hour. I am not sure you can buy ticket in bus but there is a machine in front of the bus stop. Keep your tickets (like boarding pass or train tickets) as proves of expenses.



For participants coming by train Just in front of Bordeaux Saint Jean Station (public transport, one ticket/per person is 1,50 euro) please catch the TRAM line **C** **Direction :** Bordeaux Parc Expos-Stade Matmut Atlantique / Cracovie / Gare de Blanquefort **till** PORTE de BOURGOGNE then drop out and **catch** TRAM line **A** **Direction :** DRAVEMONT and drop out at JEAN ZAY It's just 2 stops before the end of line A. If you miss it you can also leave at the next one LA MAREGUE.

Then, like colleagues coming by plane, you have a little walk to do (by around 300 meters), you will cross the motorway and then you are near (stay on the left side of the road).

Only one ticket (1,50 euro/person) for the both TRAMs if you do not exceed one hour including the connection. You have to buy tickets in the machine in front of the station and keep them as proof.
