Summary of study/report	In its 4th annual report, the Observatory of Secularism stresses a still very strong sensitivity on any situation that affects secularism and religious facts. Tensions and annoyances on these subjects remain important even if the challenges of the principle of secularism appear better contained thanks to the multiplication, in recent years and intended for the actors in the field, of formation to secularism and the management of religious facts. The Observatory of Secularism is concerned with helping to ensure the firm and serene application of the principles on which secularism is founded, to recall the legal framework permitting the sanctioning of all acts which, without directly affecting secularism, To the minimal requirements of life in society, and finally, to do pedagogy.
