Internet access - those of you who have Eduroam can automatically connect with the university system. For those of you that do not have eduroam the university will supply a user name and access code for the duration of the meeting.

The meetings and symposium will be held at the residence as well. So you will not need to travel to and for the meetings.

#### Information to get from airport to hotel

You will all arrive at the Malta International Airport. To get to your hotel you can either get a:

**BUS** - To reaching your hotel from the airport by bus take the X1, X2, X3 or the X4 to Valletta. Change in Valletta, get no. 54 and stop at Tabor. The stop is in from of the Hotel. The bus takes long but it only costs €2,00.

SHUTTLE SERVICE - Malta Transfer is MIA's official shuttle service. It offers convenient trips to and from your hotel in Malta or Gozo. You can manage your transfers with fixed prices through the booking system here. Alternatively, you can visit the booking desk in our baggage reclaim area and make your transfer arrangements upon your arrival in Malta.

**Taxi** - Pre-paid tickets can be purchased at fixed rates from a booth in our Welcomers Hall. A regular taxi normally accommodates four persons, however the number of suitcases being carried must also be taken into consideration with regard to the space required in the vehicle. **Cost is fixed at 20 euro per taxi**.
