1 - What institutional barriers do you face in your country which limits prisoners' involvement in education?

The most relevant institutional barriers are related with:

- a. the reduced number of staff involved in educational activities
- b. difficult access to ICT tools

2 - What promising/inspiring practices/projects exist in your country to motivate and support prisoners into education?

Regarding minors and youth education in prison, the most relevant practices are:

- a. the educational programs, social programs and psychological intervention which is assured for each prisoner
- b. common programs organised inside and outside the prison with community representatives
- c. contract for the prisoners in order to work inside and outside the prison
- d. the possibility for some of the prisoners to continue their school outside the prison during the sentence
- e. continuous relation with the prisoners'families, programs organised inside and outside the prison involving the inmates and their families.
